Re: 2017 Trip to China

Introduction

China represents an important and growing market for the ski and tourism industry in Canada. Indeed, China is now the #2 source of international visitors to British Columbia and the #4 source of international visitors to Canada. Moreover, the Chinese ski industry has been growing rapidly in recent years, and Beijing will be hosting the 2022 Winter Olympic Games.

In light of these developments, the CSC has been approached to coordinate a greater understanding of Chinese tourism opportunities and the Chinese ski market in specifics. At this juncture, we believe that it would be timely to organize a second industry-level trip to China in conjunction with the World Winter Sports Expo (http://www.wwse2022.com) in Beijing. This event will run from September 7, 2017 to September 11, 2017.

Objectives

The primary objectives of the CSC Trip to China are as follows:

- 1. To create opportunities for member organizations and respective members to do business with China.
- 2. To facilitate growth in Chinese tourist arrivals and Chinese destination skier visits to Canada.
- 3. To establish mutually beneficial relationships between the Canadian & Chinese ski industries.
- 4. To expand our knowledge of resort development, by studying the Chinese resort industry.

- O Wednesday September 14, 2017 return to Canada.
- Additional meetings with the China Ski Association and the Olympic Committee are being investigated.
